MID-SEMESTER REPORTS

The first mid-semester report is due to be given out to the students on the last day before the Easter holidays: Thursday 1 April. (That's no joke!) NO EASTER HOLIDAY PROGRAMME

ASSEMBLIES

SECURITY

Parents, please ask your drivers to collect a JIMS security card as they drive into school. We now have a newly appointed Security Supervisor as we take the matter

of security of your children very seriously. At present, there is the odd driver who refuses to accept the security card.

CLASS PARTIES

While we welcome class parties for special occasions, we wish to point out that the teaching may be interrupted only for that **extraordinary** day, such as a birthday or a farewell when students leave Indonesia and won't be returning.

PUNCTUALITY

It is important that students arrive at school on time. They must be ready to start class at 8.00 am, otherwise the teacher and all the other students in the class will be interrupted. Children who arrive late must collect a 'late pass' from the front office receptionist before being allowed into the class. This will allow the school to monitor that all students have been accounted for. We thank you for your cooperation in this important matter, so that we can teach students that punctuality demonstrates **courtesy** towards other people in the class.

LOST PROPERTY

We are constantly faced with the problem of lost property. **Please mark your child's possessions and clothes.** Ms Windri (Penguins) looks after all lost property and has a basket full of items that were found around the school. Please go and see her to check that none of the uniforms, books, bottles, etc. are yours. Then we can clean out all the items before the holidays.
