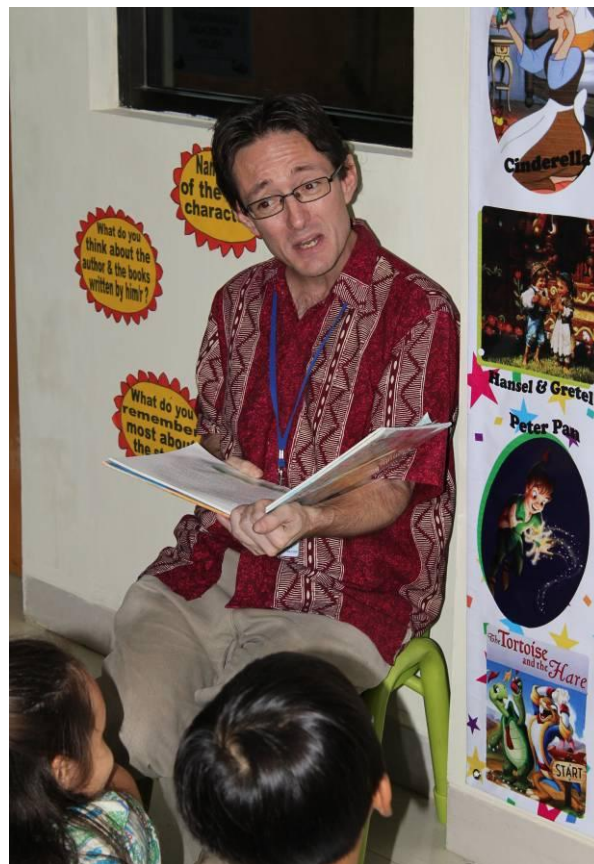


Dear Parents

PE - UNIFORMS

This is a reminder that, for PE classes, students must wear **PE uniforms**: blue shorts and JIMS T-shirt.
