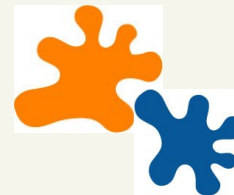




# Parent Update

Any library books borrowed this week will be due back during the first week after the holidays.



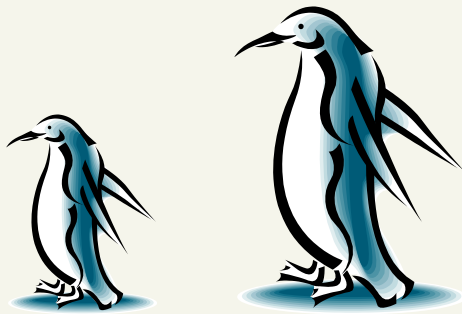
The Penguins have been very busy. Their writing skills are improving all the time!

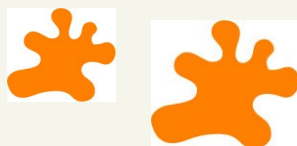
